Bob Davis recommended looking into getting a CPR class held at the township building and also looking into getting some life saving devices and volunteers in the community to help provide a quicker response to emergencies.

<u>Plant project updates</u> Wilson stated that the replacement of the 2 Reed Beds was complete and that they are currently in the process of moving the flow meter. Wilson also stated that the EADS Group completed some testing that provides proof that a pump station is not going to be needed after the flow meter is relocated.

<u>PA Municipal Services Ordinance Enactment</u> The supervisors enacted an ordinance that was needed to outsource the sewage building which has been previously done in-house. Wilson explained that it should end up being cheaper to the township and will alleviate a lot of burden on the township secretary.

Wilson responded that it will alleviate burden on the township. Dee Chaney asked when it will take effect, Wilson responded within a month or two after enacting the ordinance and stated that customers will be notified ahead of time. All 3 supervisors and township secretary signed and enacted the ordinance.

<u>Sewage Public Forum</u> Bob Davis asked Wilson if he turned in hours for planting the reeds in the reed beds at the sewage plant. Wilson responded that he did not. Bob Davis stated he asks as a resident of the township that Wilson turn hours in when he performs work.
