A resident asked if Summerson Road was going to be finished somehow and that the road is like a washboard. The road looks to have grit on it instead of the chip and it's in clumps. Dave Weber said that Summerson Road was completed on Tuesday. Tom is going to take a look at Summerson Road.

Tom Wilson had a complaint about Dents Run being rough due to potholes. Tom Wilson asked that Dave Weber gets to Dents Run to the potholes fixed, Dave said, at some point. Tom said that no one has been back Dents Run yet this year and that the potholes are getting bad back Grant too. Bob Trayer said Huston is also bad. Tom Wilson wants road checks done more often. After a storm someone needs to go out and check the roads. Bob Trayer said he will take it upon himself to do the road checks since he lives up on the hill.

Tom Wilson mentioned there is a driveway that the campers aren't going to be able to access if they have a car on Porcupine because the grader took too much off and that this needs fixed. Dave Weber stated the driveway needs a cross pipe. Bob Trayer said he will get the skid steer from Huston Road before they start the tar and chip project on Wednesday.

A resident asked what all roads are getting tarred and chipped. Dave Weber answered Kelly, Porcupine down to where it levels off, and the bottom of Summerson. The resident asked about Tucker Lane and Dave Weber said that Jay Township did Tucker Lane. The resident also asked about Dave Weber's driveway and Dave Weber said he paid Jay Township workers and paid for the gravel to tar and chip his driveway. Dave Weber said there were no Benezette Township workers up on his property working. Dave Weber said the stone for private jobs was hauled in by Delullo. Tom Wislon verified with Dave Weber for clarification that no Benezette Township workers were there and no Benezette Township equipment was used. Dave said no, they were all on Summerson Road. When we get the bill from Jay Township it will be looked over well to ensure there are no private roads added to the bill.
